APPLICATION

If applied directly onto the existing plaster, take care that the substrate is stable, solid and without dust or detaching parts. Apply at least 10 days after the last layer complete drying. Do not wet the surface before application. If the support is highly absorbent it is strictly suggested to apply first *D20* fixing primer.

- 1. Dilute the product with 10-20% of water.
- **2.** Once the *D*20 fixative is completely dry, apply a first coat by trowel, obtaining a levelled layer.
- **3.** Once the first coat is dry, apply the second coat, without diluting the product.
- **4.** After 15 minutes from last coat application, smooth the product using a sponge, working in clockwise direction.

SUGGESTIONS

- The substrate must be stable, solid and completely dry, without debris or detaching parts, efflorescences or organic materials.
- If applied onto a high-absorbing support, D20 fixative is strictly suggested (see Diasen Primer).
- The application on the wall must be completed in one day, avoiding to apply the following coats the day after.
- The surface temperature must be between +5°C and +35°C.
- If applied directly onto a highly-unlevelled plaster, it is suggested to apply first a levelling smoother, such as Argacem HP.
- Wear protective clothing while handling the product.
- · Wash tools with water.
